**PRIVATE SWIMMING POOLS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Section R4501.17 of the 2014 Florida Building Code and Chapter 515 of Florida Statutes requires the provision of specific pool barriers around the entire perimeter of the pool. In addition to this executed affidavit, all provisions for the required pool barrier shall be shown on the plans, and manufacturer’s product compliance information must be supplied.

I (We) acknowledge that a new swimming pool, spa or hot tub will be constructed or installed at the above address, and hereby affirm that one or more of the following methods will be used to meet the requirements of the Florida Building Code, R4501.17 and Florida Statutes, Chapter 515.

\_\_\_\_\_ The pool will be equipped with an approved safety pool cover that complies with ASTM F 1346, Standard Performance Specifications for Safety Covers for Swimming Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs.

\_\_\_\_\_ A continuous barrier (“Kiddie/Child Fence”) will be used to isolate the pool from the home. Plans submitted to show the location of the end which is not removable without the use of tools. Must comply with R4501.17.1.15 Florida Residential Building Code, which includes ASTM D 5034 and ASTM D 3787 and ASTM G 53

\_\_\_\_\_ A continuous barrier such as a dwelling wall, screen enclosure or fence that meet R4501.17 shall be used to prevent external access to the pool. Additionally, all doors and windows that meet R4501.17 that lead to the pool from the interior of the home, shall have an exit alarm meeting the requirements of UL 2017.

## **INSPECTION SEQUENCE FOR SWIMMING POOLS**

1. Reinforcing steel, main drain, bonding
2. Perimeter Pipe
3. Deck Rough, Deck Steel, Jigs (ladders and handrails) Bonding
4. Equipotential Bonding
5. Electrical Final – All equipment hard wired, ready for start up
6. Gas work by separate permit
- \*7. Barrier – All Devices and/or systems which compromise the barrier, i.e fences, alarms must be in place and active. Covers and kiddie fences shall be on site. This inspection must pass before marcite and filling of pool.
8. Pool Final
