

RESOLUTION NO. 87-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY; AMENDING RESOLUTION 71-20 BY PROVIDING FOR THE RE-OPENING OF THE DELRAY BEACH PUBLIC LIBRARY AND ALL CITY OF DELRAY BEACH MUSEUMS; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency in the City of Delray Beach was proclaimed by the City Commission on March 13, 2020 due to the spread of the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the City Manager executed City of Delray Beach Resolution 71-20 in response to the conditions arising from COVID-19 which were threatening safety and security of the citizens of Delray Beach; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 71-20, *inter alia*, designated certain areas off limits to all members of the public except personnel authorized by the Police and Fire Departments; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2020, Governor Ron Desantis issued Executive Order 20-112, "Phase 1: Safe. Smart. Step-by-Step. Plan for Florida's Recovery" providing for a phased path to re-opening the State of Florida safely and strategically; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to re-open the Delray Beach Public Library and all City of Delray Beach Museums in order to remain consistent with the Governor's phased approach to re-opening the State; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 95 of the City of Delray Beach Code of Ordinances authorizes the City Manager to take necessary measures in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A declaration of a State of Emergency proclaimed on March 13, 2020 is hereby confirmed.

Section 2. The Delray Beach Public Library and all City of Delray Beach Museums may open at no more than 25 percent of their building occupancy, provided, however, that any interactive functions or exhibits, including child play areas, remain closed. This section amends and supersedes Resolution 71-20, section 2, subsections (A) and (B).

Section 3. This Resolution does not affect or limit the operations of Palm Beach County, the Palm Beach County School District, or any State or Federal office or facility.

Section 4. All requirements of City Emergency Orders, County Emergency Orders, and State of Florida Executive Orders shall be strictly adhered to at all times.


Section 5. All parts of Resolution 71-20 not expressly amended herein remain in full force and effect.
